2010 Polish Closed Championship Rules.

1. Objectives.

The Polish Championship is the annual event in our club conducted around spring each year. The objective of the event is to create an environment where playing table tennis is fun and can be done in friendly and competitive atmosphere.

The following categories will be open:

- a. OPEN
- b. AMATEURS (two categories based on age)
 - i. 45 years old or less
 - ii. older than 45 years
- c. U-1400 (rating as per CTTA, OTTA, MTL or other listings)
- d. VETERANS (player must be 55 years old or older)
- e. JUNIORS (player must be 18 years old or younger)

Note: this championship is organized for players with polish origin or polish descendants. However in U1400 and OPEN all members of Centrum Table Tennis Club are allowed, regardless of their background.

2. Cost and awards

The fee is \$25/\$20/\$10 for one category (see below), \$35 for two categories, \$45 for three categories.

Money awards will be paid out in a given category only if there will be at least 12 players participating.

3. Matches.

- a. Matches are conducted according to the ITTF laws
- b. Matches will be scored as best 3 of 5 sets (11 points set) game
- c. Warm up before the match is 5 minutes and maximum rest time between matches is 10 minutes.

4. Distribution of players.

- a. Initially all players will be divided into groups of 3-4 players. All players will play with all other players in the group. The first two will advance to the next phase of matches based on straight elimination.
- b. Players will be distributed to groups based on:
 - i. 1-4 from last year finalists
 - ii. 5-12 based on the Polish Championship rating list
 - iii. 13-16 based on allocation done by the Referee
- c. Match schedules will be established just before the start of each category depending on the number of participants.

5. Amateur Category. Additional clarification of these categories:

- a. Only player that has <1200 points on any rating list (eg. CTTA, OTTA, MTL) in 2004-2010 can participate in this category.
- b. Player that were playing in semifinals of U-1400 or quarterfinals of OPEN in 2009, can not play in this category.
- c. A deviation from the above is:
 - i. 55 years and older and up to 1275 points
 - ii. 50 to 55 years and up to 1250 points
 - iii. For all others up to 1225 points

6. Issues resolution, player's qualification or other concerns.

- a. All referee's decisions are final and all participants agree to abide by them.
- b. The Referee can disqualify a player if he/she plays at the level well above the average player in that category and other players will complain formally paying fee of \$50
- c. The Referee may change the rules based on his assessment of a situation.

7. Dress Code.

It is expected that each player will wear a sport shoes, shirts, shorts or tracksuits. However shirts in majority white or orange are NOT allowed.

8. Injuries and stolen or lost articles.

The tournament's organizers and owners of the premises will not be liable for any accident or damage which may result from participation in this event.
