This event has 2 categories: U1400 and Open. There are 8 tournaments as per the dates below. Results from these tournaments will be used to determine the Presidents Cup winner. Prize money will be awarded to the Cup winner, as well as to winners of the individual tournaments. Please refer to the Tournament Rules section for further details.

Tournament Rules

The tournament objective is to popularize the sport of table tennis by providing an opportunity to compete in a friendly environment.

The following rules are set:

1. The tournament fee is \$10/category but for CTTC members the fee is \$5/category. All entries must be received before the tournament start time at least 24 hours by email.
2. Tournaments will be conducted according to the ITTF laws.
3. All referee's decisions are final and all participants agree to abide by them.
4. The tournament's participant agrees that organizers of the tournaments and owners of the premises will not be liable for any accident or damage which may result from my participation in these tournaments.
5. A preliminary round robin will be played in each event.
6. Matches will be scored as best 3 of 5 sets (11 points set) game
7. Match schedules will be established just before the start of each tournament depending on the number of participant.
8. To qualify for U1400 category, a player's ranking will be used as per OTTA or MTTL (or their average). The following exceptions apply: men over 55 years old & women must be under 1500.
9. The President reserves the right to disqualify any player who is not rated on any of the above lists but will present a skills level above the expected and allowed rating.
10. The starting distribution of players at each tournament is defined by:
 - place 1 to 4 from the last tournament
 - place 5 to 16 from the overall ranking list
 - place 17 to 20 up to the organization's discretion
 - the rest of players in order of applications
11. The tournament has a limit of maximum 24 players per category.
12. The best 6 games out of 8 for each player will be used for final classification.
13. The rating points are:
1st – 50 points, 2nd – 46 points, 3rd–43 points, 4th–40 points, 5–8th –35 points, 9–12th–30 points, 13–16th – 25 points, 17–20th–20 points
14. The CTTC President's Tournament awards for each tournament are as follows:
U1400: 1st place is \$50, 2nd place is \$30 and 3rd is \$20
Open: 1st place is \$60, 2nd place is \$40 and 3rd is \$30
These awards may be adjusted if there is no sufficient participation.
15. The CTTC President's Tournament final awards are to be determined later based on participation.
16. Final celebration will take place in June 2007.
17. The tournament dates or rules may change as unforeseen circumstances arise.
