



The Club Rules for 2008/2009

The CTTC was established around 1995. The main objective of the club is to provide players associated with or who are part of the Polish community the opportunity to play table tennis. However the club is open to all table tennis players regardless of background. The intention of the club governing body is to create opportunities for practice and to playing games, at both the recreational and competitive levels.

Here are rules and guidelines to be followed by all members.

1. **Club structure.** The club board is selected from the members of the club. The 2008/2009 season board is proposed to be made out of the following functions and people:
 - 1.1. President: Jan Walczak
 - 1.2. Board Members: Krzysztof Smektala, Jacek Sokolowski, Krzysztof Wspanialy, Jerzy Watracz and Andrzej Zak
2. **Practice Season**
 - 2.1. Season starts in September and ends in June.
 - 2.2. Club hours are
 - 2.2.1. Monday from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm
 - 2.2.2. Wednesday from 8:00 pm to 10:30 pm
 - 2.2.3. Saturdays from 9:00 am to 11:00 am
 - 2.2.4. Other days may be announced by the board member
 - 2.3. Time of practice may be changed and will be announced by the board member.
3. **Membership.**
 - 3.1. Membership is open to all people willing to play table tennis and follow the club rules.
 - 3.2. Anyone can become a member after paying club fees and completing the registration form.
 - 3.3. Members must agree to follow all club rules and regulations.
 - 3.4. Membership cannot be passed to other person.
4. **Practicing rights.** In order to use club properties for the purpose of playing table tennis, all members must satisfy the following criteria:
 - 4.1. All members have paid their membership fees
 - 4.2. Only people who paid full membership have the right to play in the Mississauga League.
 - 4.3. All other people that have been given permission to play by the member of the board after paying 1 time fee.
 - 4.3.1. This kind of permission will be given only if there is enough room for additional players.
 - 4.3.2. This applies to family or friends of members.
 - 4.3.3. Current visitor fees are set at \$6.00 for adult and \$3.00 for juniors per night.



5. Practice rules

- 5.1. All players will follow activity supervisor (usually board member) direction regarding all activities in the club.
- 5.2. The game rules follows ITTF rules (for more details refer to <http://www.ittf.com/> and select Regulations)
- 5.3. Dress - a proper table tennis attire is dark solid color clothing. And running shoes must be worn during play.
- 5.4. All members have the right to use club equipment
- 5.5. All players are responsible for:
 - 5.5.1. At the beginning of practice for a table setup (tables, nets, dividers)
 - 5.5.2. At the end of practice for table dismantling and putting away in designated areas (this responsibility lands on the last person playing on that table)
- 5.6. Each player is responsible for cleaning up his/her own garbage
- 5.7. Activity supervisor is usually board member but it could be other designated person. This person will oversee practice on a given day, and particularly:
 - 5.7.1. Ensure that practice will start and end at the designated time
 - 5.7.2. Ensure the club equipment is properly used and secured (tables, nets, etc)
 - 5.7.3. Monitor and engage players in the equipment handling if necessary
 - 5.7.4. Ensure that all players can play – implement players rotation if needed
- 5.8. Whenever number of players exceed club capacity, the max play time may be limited to 30min

6. Accidents and damages.

- 6.1. The club and its officials, affiliates or sponsors do not assume responsibility for any injury, damage or loss resulting from any known or unknown conditions, handicap or infection howsoever caused
- 6.2. Damages to the club properties or Centrum properties are responsibility of the person that caused it. Therefore the damages have to be repaired or paid for within the time as established by the CTTC board. Lack of such restitutes may result in membership cancellation and/or visitors privileges.
- 6.3. The club and its officials, affiliates or sponsors do not assume responsibility for lost or stolen money or other valuables in the club area.
