2011 Polish Closed Tournament Rules.

1. Objectives.

The Polish Championship is the annual event in our club conducted around spring each year. The objective of the event is to create an environment where playing table tennis is fun and can be done in friendly and competitive atmosphere.

General rules:

- The tournament is “Closed” - it is for a person that fit any of these categories:
 - is of polish origin or polish descendants
 - is a member of Centrum Table Tennis Club
- Player’s category will be based primarily on MTTL rating but other ratings may be considered as needed.
- Veterans category is for players that are 55 years old or older.

2. Matches.

- a. Matches are conducted according to the ITTF laws
- b. Matches will be scored as best 3 of 5 sets (11 points set) game
- c. Warm up before the match is 5 minutes and maximum rest time between matches is 10 minutes.

3. Distribution of players.

- a. Initially all players will be divided into groups of 3-4 players. All players will play with all other players in the group. The first two will advance to the next phase of matches based on straight elimination.
- b. Players will be distributed to groups based on:
 - i. 1-4 from last year finalists
 - ii. 5-12 based on the Polish Championship rating list
 - iii. 13-16 based on allocation done by the Referee
- c. Match schedules will be established just before the start of each category depending on the number of participants.

4. Issues resolution, player’s qualification or other concerns.

- a. Players who qualified to finals(1st and 2nd place), cannot play in lower categories, ie finalists in Open or Veterans cannot play in U-1200 or U-900, finalists in U-1200 cannot play in U-900. But if they did, than they will be disqualified and fee will be returned to them.
- b. All referee’s decisions are final and all participants agree to abide by them.
- c. The Referee may change the rules based on his assessment of a situation.
- d. The Referee can disqualify a player if he/she plays at the level well above the average player in that category and other players will complain formally paying fee of \$50

5. Dress Code.

It is expected that each player will wear a sport shoes, shirts, shorts or tracksuits. However shirts in majority white or orange are NOT allowed.

6. Injuries and stolen or lost articles.

The tournament’s organizers and owners of the premises will not be liable for any accident or damage which my result from participation in this event.
